MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT entered into this eleventh day of July A.D. 1938

BETWEEN:

HIS MAJESTY THE KING in the right of the DOMINION OF CANADA (hereinafter called the "Dominion"), represented herein by the Honourable Norman McLeod Rogers, Minister of Labour,

OF THE FIRST PART

AND

HIS MAJESTY THE KING in the right of
the PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN (hereinafter called the "Province"), represented
herein by the Honourable Reginald John
Marsden Parker, Minister of Municipal Affairs,

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS The Unemployment and Agricultural
Assistance Act, 1938, empowers His Excellency the Governor
in Council to enter into agreements with any of the Provinces
respecting the alleviation of unemployment conditions and of
agricultural distress therein and to assist those in need and
provides for payments for such purposes to be made out of
moneys appropriated by Parliament for the fiscal year ending
March 31, 1939;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the conditions pursuant to which monthly Dominion grants-in-aid in respect of the aforesaid alleviation may be made to the Province during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1939, should be embodied in a written agreement:
