


Ottawa, March 6, 1918.

Sir,-

I beg to advise you that the Department is in receipt of a communication from Mr. L. H. Leeson, teacher of the Moraviantown Indian School, in which he states that on account of agricultural demands and through personal request to work on their farm at home, he is tendering his resignation as teacher of this school.

Mr. Leeson's resignation has been accepted and the Rev. J. H. Arnup, Assistant Secretary for Foreign Missions of the Methodist Missionary Society, has been written to and asked to take the necessary steps to secure a properly qualified teacher to take charge of this school after the Easter holidays.
