

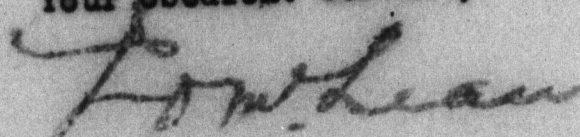

Ottawa, 5th April 1919.

Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 31st ultimo and preceeding correspondence I have to say that you may make an estimate of the cost of the work proposed to be executed on the road on the West boundary of the Garden River Indian reserve near the Indian village and then submit the matter to the Indian Council in order that they may, if they so desire, pass a resolution requesting that the sum required be taken from their Capital funds.
