First
Witness

K50189, L/Sgt. McKay, D.H., The Seaforth Highlanders of Canada,
states:-

I was Ord Sers. for "D" Coy, Seaforth of C from 0900 hrs 22 Sep
41 to 0900 hrs 29 Sep 41. On 25 Sep 41 Pte. White was given a
pass which was valid until 2359 hrs 25 Sep 41. He did not
return at the time the pass expired and was absent from parade
when the Bn moved off on exercise "BUMPER" at approx. 0530 hrs
26 Sep 41. Pte. White had not reported in at the expiration of
my tour of duty at 0900 hrs 29 Sep 41. Pte White was still
absent at 0900 hrs 15 Oct 41 when I again took over the duties
of Ord. Sgt. for "D" Coy and continued to be absent until 1200
hrs 16 Oct 41 at which time he reported in to me.

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.

K52892, Sgt. Byatt, W.F., The Seaforth Highlanders of Canada,
States:-

I am and was at all times material hereto Pl. Sgt. of No. 17 Pl.
Seaforth of C. Pte. White is a member of No. 17 Pl. On 26 Sep
41 when on exercise "BUMPER" I was instructed to replace Pte.
White in "D" Coy kitchen. I enquired the reason for this and
was informed that he was absent. I would not know this as being
in the kitchen he would not parade with the Pl. on the morning
of 26 Sep 41 when the Bn moved off on exercise "BUMPER".
From 26 Sep 41 until 15 Oct 41 Pte. White was still absent. On
15 Oct 41 I went on 48 hrs leave and on my return I was informed
that Pte. White had reported back.

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.
