Word and Saeraments; and that he may be a godly example to the people committed to his charge; so that, after this life is ended, they may come together to thy heavenly kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, by whose Spirit the whole body of the Church is governed and sanctified: Receive our supplications and prayers, which we offer before thee, for all estates of men in thy holy Church; that every member of the same, in his vocation and ministry, may truly and godly serve thee; through our Lord and Savionr Jesus Christ. Amen.

THE peace of God, which passeth all understanding, keep your hearts and minds in the knowledge and love of God, and of his Son Jesns Christ our Lord: And the blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, be amongst you and remain with you always. Amen.

If the Institution hath taken place elsewhere, then instead of the Address at the beginning of this form, the Archdeacon (or his deputy), standing by the Lord's T-ble, shall address the people as followeth.

DEARLY beloved in the Lord, forasmuch as our well-beloved in Christ, N., hath been appointed and instituted into the Cure of Souls in this Parish by the Bishop of the Diocese; and forasmuch as the Bishop hath issued his Mandate to induct him into the Incombency thereof; we are assembled together here this day to induct the said N. into the Incombency of this Parish, with all the rights and emoluments thereto belonging.
