



HISTORICAL NOTES.

- 1845, June 23—Purchase of church property.
- 1855—First church built and Rev. John Gauld inducted.
- 1856, July—First communion administered.
June 28—First meeting of session recorded, held at home of late Finlay Farquharson.
- 1862, June 24—Purchase of land for glebe.
Resignation of Rev. John Gauld.
- 1864, April 28—Rev. Peter McDermid inducted.
- 1865, November 1—Completion of manse building.
- 1867, December 5—First church burned.
- 1868, October 5—First meeting held in new church.
- 1877—Rev. Peter McDermid resigned.
- 1879, April 16—Rev. J. A. McDonald inducted.
- 1889, July 8—Instrumental music introduced.
- 1890, August—Rev. J. A. McDonald resigned.
October 1—Rev. J. C. McKee preached first sermon.
- 1891, July 21—Rev. J. C. McKee inducted.
- 1898, February 20—Hymnal introduced and congregation enjoined to stand while singing.
- 1904, August 4—Resignation of Rev. J. C. McKee.
- 1905, March 29—Rev. W. Reid inducted.
November 13—Purchase of property for manse for joint congregations of Bear Creek and Bridglen.
