These office-bearers, with a Board of Directors composed of clergymen and laymen of various denominations, are elected annually. The Society was incorporated in 1872. Its expenditures in twelve years amounted to about \$300,000. It received in donations over \$40,000; and it circulated publications to the value of over \$265,000. The publications circulated are mainly those of the Religious Tract Society of London, and other non-denominational publishing houses. About \$50,000 have been spent in Colportage, and 150 years of labor were devoted to this object. Religious books, tracts, magazines, sabbath school papers, libraries at half price, etc., are specialties of the Society's Depository. The operations of the Society are directed by an executive committee which meets monthly and by sub-committees on colportage, publications and finance.
