An Act to continue the Act to direct and ascertain the mode of Assessing County and District Rates, and for other purposes, and the Acts in amendment thereof.

(Passed the 27th Day of March, 1840.)

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act, passed in the Fifth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act to direct and ascertain the mode of assessing County and District Rates, and for other purposes, except so far as the same is altered or amended by the Acts hereinafter mentioned, and also, except the eighth clause or section thereof, which is hereby repealed; also, the Act, passed in the Sixth Year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, entitled, An Act to amend the Act to direct and ascertain the mode of assessing County and District Rates, and for other purposes; also, the Act, passed in the First Year of Her Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act to continue the Act to direct and ascertain the mode of assessing County and District Rates, and for other purposes, and the Acts in amendment thereof, except in so far as the same may be altered or amended by the Act hereinafter mentioned; also, the Act, passed in the Second Year of Her present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act to continue and further amend the Act to direct and ascertain the mode of assessing County and District Rates, and for other purposes, and the Act in amendment thereof, shall be continued, and the said Acts, except as before excepted, are hereby severally continued for one year, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. CIV.

An Act to continue the Act relating to Passengers from Great Britain and Ireland, and the Acts in amendment thereof.

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the Second Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act relating to Passengers from Great Britain and Ireland, arriving in this Province; also, the Act, passed in the Sixth Year of His said late Majesty's Reign, to continue and amend the said Act; also, the Act, passed in the Second Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, to amend the said Act, shall be continued, and the said several Acts are hereby respectively continued for one year, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

An Act to continue the Act concerning Malicious Injuries to Property.

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the Second Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act concerning Malicious Injuries to Property, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued for one year, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
