CAP. LXI.

An Act to continue the Act respecting the Collection of Poor's Rates of Pictou, as amended.

(Passed the Sth day of March, A. D. 1845.)

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the Sixth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act respecting the Collection of Poor's Rates of Pictou, except in so far as the same is altered or amended by the Act, passed in the Fifth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, entitled, An Act to amend the Acts respecting the Collection of Poor's Rates of Pictou and Egerton, shall be continued, and the said first mentioned Act, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, except as before excepted, are hereby continued for One. Year, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. LXII.

An Act to continue the Acts now in force to regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Sydney, in the Island of Cape Breton.

(Passed the Sth day of March, A. D. 1845.)

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the First Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act to regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Sydney, in the Island of Breton, save and except so far as the same is or may be altered or amended by the Act hereinafter mentioned; and also the Act, passed in the Fifth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, entitled, An Act to continue and amend the Act to regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Sydney, in the Island of Cape Breton, and to repeal certain Acts relative thereto, shall be continued, and the said Acts, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, except as before excepted, are hereby respectively continued, for One Year, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. LXIII.

An Act to continue the Act in amendment of the Act for the Settlement of the Poor in the several Townships within this Province.
