FAIR, THEN SNOW AND MILD.

Toronto, Dec. 13.—11 p.m.—The high pressure area from the Northwest is now central over Eastern Ontario and Western Quebec, and is moving east very rapidly. In the Northwest high pressure and very cold weather still prevails. There is a general decrease in pressure over the Western States, which is extending toward the lakes.

Minimum and maximum temperatures: Calgary, 26° below—14° below; Edmonton, 22° below—14° below; Qu'Appelle, 20° below—8° below; Winnipeg, 38° below—4° below; Port Arthur, 22° below—4° below; Toronto, 4°—14°; Kingston, 10°—2° below; Halifax, 8°—16°.

Interment took place at Woodland Cemetery.

Accidentally Killed.

Coroner Block concluded the inquest concerning the demise of Mr. Frank Taylor and Mrs. Maria Wilson at Kerwood yesterday by the jury returning a verdict of accidental death. The railway company was completely exonerated. Engineer Kirkpatrick, who was in charge, is considered one of the most careful drivers on the line, and his record is unimpeachable.

It was the evidence of several witnesses that shown that the bell and whistle were both utilized in sounding the alarm. It was also shown that the mufflers when were about the ears of the victims must have militated against their hearing the signal. A recommendation was made by the jury to the

The Patrons' Platform.

The following is the platform of the Patrons of Industry as adopted by the Grand Association of Ontario and Quebec at London on Sept. 22, 1891:

1. Maintenance of British connection.

2. The reservation of the public lands for the actual settler.

3. Purity of administration and absolute independence of Parliament.

4. Rigidity economy in every department of the public service.

5. Simplification of the laws and a general reduction in the machinery of government.

6. The abolition of the Canadian Senate.

7. A system of civil service reform that will give each county officer to appoint in each county officials paid
