Mr. Metcalfe thought that the project was a long time ahead of the times. Cold storage, rather than warehouses, seemed to him to be desirable at the present time. It would be a great mistake too at time. 
resolution was put and lost. COLD STORAGE. In speaking to this question, Mr. J. C. Metcalfe read the resolution of last year, which ran as follows:

Metcalfe read the resolution of last year, which ran as follows:

"Whereas it is known that for the development of export trade in agricultural products of a perishable nature, the development of cold storage stations in rural districts where fruits, dairy products, fowls, meats, etc., can be kept until it is advisable to ship is necessary, therefore be it resolved, that in the opinion of the members of this institute it is important and necessary that the legislature of the province should introduce a measure to provide for the incorporation of co-operative cold storage associations, and to further provide and assist by paying in part the cost of construction and equipment of any building erected for cold storage purposes incorporated under the act in rural districts."

In Ontario, he said, a cheap and ready system had been in operation for two years along these lines of co-operation amongst the farmers, coupled with a certain rmount of government assistance. The measure provides a simple and cheap method of incorporation for those seeking to associate themselves for this purpose. Any five or more desirous of forming such an association can do so by merely signing a certificate tecording to a form provided and adopting rules and regulations. The certificate and rules are then required to be registered, a fee of 50 cents being all the outlay required. Tho amount of shares which any one member may hold is limited to \$1,000, which are transferable with the consent and approval of the association. The liability (Continued on Page Eight.)
