The Manitoba people are still holding their crop, and there are those who fear that this course will place the Duluth wheat in the Liverpool market to the exclusion to a considerable extent of Canadian Northwest wheat. There is a foundation for this fear, and the result would be a drop instead of a raise in prices.


