sion in Fuegia. Our readers will have heard of the sad end of that mission, how the whole band perished from exposure and starvation. It is gratifying, however, to know that the work has not been given up, but that other labourers, among whom is the son of Captain Gardiner, are seeking the spiritual improvement of the degraded natives in Terra de Fuego.

THE SUPERNATURAL IN RELATION TO THE NATURAL—By the Rev. Jas. McCosh, LL.D., author of "The Method of the Divine Government," &c., &c. New York: R. Carter & Brothers. Sold by D. McLellan, Hamilton.

The author of this volume having intended to follow up his work on "The Method of the Divine Government, Physical and Moral," by another on "The Method of the Divine Government, Supernatural and Spiritual," issues this as the first part of his contemplated work. Those who have read his former productions will find here the same mental vigour, the same careful analysis, and the same lucid style. Indirectly he replies in a very satisfactory manner to some of the writers of "Essays and Reviews." We may notice the work more at length in another volume. In the meantime we cheerfully recommend it especially to ministers and students as a work well worthy of their pevusal.
