At Leeds Manso, on the 2nd June, Benjamin, fourth son of the Rev. James McConechy, aged seventeen years.

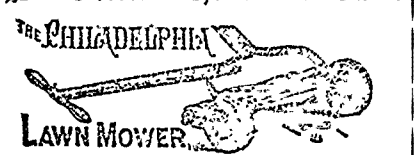

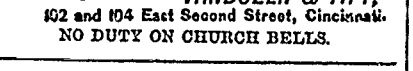
