## CHAPTER I

## I\_N\_T\_R\_O\_D\_U\_C\_T\_I\_O\_N.

This Report covers the activities of the International Commission for Supervision & Control in Cambodia for the period, the 1st of January 1957 to the 31st of December 1957. During this period, the International Commission held 33 regular meetings and 2 extraordinary meetings. There were 5 meetings of the Political Advisers' Committee and 7 meetings of the Military Advisers' Committee.

- There were also three Co-ordination Conferences of all the three Secretaries-General, two at Hanoi in March and June 1957 and one at Siem Reap in November 1957 to discuss common administrative matters.
- The Commission's residual responsibilities during the period under review arose out of articles 6, 7, 13(c) and 21 of the Geneva Agreement for Cambodia.
