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THE CANADIAN FEDERATION OF CHEFS AND COOKS CULINARY EXCHANGE PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT?

The Canadian Federation of Chefs and Cooks and the American Culinary Federation have agreed to work together to further exploration and discovery in culinary arts. The Culinary Exchange Program provides the opportunity for culinary apprentice graduates to expand their culinary skills and international repertoire, thereby enhancing the Canadian hospitality and tourism industries.

How LONG CAN I STAY?

Culinary exchanges are for a minimum of three months to a maximum of 12 months.

WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible applicants must be:

- at least 18 years of age;
- a recent culinary apprentice graduate; and
- an active member in good standing of their respective junior or local CFCC chapter/branch.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Applicants must submit the following documentation:

- completed application;
- personal résumé;
- letters of reference from a present employer and the president of the local CFCC chapter;
- copy of journeyman's certificate of apprenticeship or equivalent;
- 150 word essay outlining reasons for wanting to participate in the program;
- proof of Canadian citizenship or landed immigrant status; and
- health certificate from family physician outlining any medical concerns.

A photograph is optional.
