

21. The Bundeswehr shall be permitted, to the extent agreed upon with the Base Commander at CFB SHILO, to share in the use of the recreational facilities and services of the Canadian Forces.
22. The Bundeswehr shall be responsible in accordance with CFB SHILO Standing Orders for taking initial fire fighting measures in the event of a fire, but overall control shall be exercised throughout by the appropriate Canadian military authorities.
23. Due attention shall be paid by the Bundeswehr to the environment, and any regulations applicable to the Canadian Forces in respect of environmental conditions and restrictions shall be strictly adhered to.
24. The Federal Ministry of Defence shall be responsible in accordance with CFB SHILO Standing Orders for the clearance of the land used by the Bundeswehr including the removal of unexploded rounds and field works with such thoroughness as may be reasonable in the circumstances.
25. Surplus Bundeswehr material which is to be disposed of in Canada shall be disposed of by the Canadian Forces through Crown Assets Disposal Corporation.
