A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS We are desirous and resolved, as soon as may be, to meet Our
People of Canada, and to have their advice in Parliament:

WE DO MAKE KNOWN Our Royal Will and pleasure to call a Parliament,
and do further declare that by the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada,
We have this day given Orders for issuing Our WRITS in due form for calling
a PARLIAMENT in Canada, which Writs are to bear date of the sixth day of
February, 1963, and to be returnable on the eighth day of May, 1963.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent
and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: Our
Trusty and Well-beloved Major-General GEORGE PHILIAS VANIER,
Companion of Our Distinguished Service Order upon whom We have
conferred Our Military Cross and Our Canadian Forces' Decoration,
Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE, in Our City of Ottawa, this sixth day of February
in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three
and in the twelfth year of Our Reign.
