

Mr. WHELAN: At the front of the book of minutes of our proceedings there is a list of the members of the committee. A druggist asked me, "What in the world are you doing on that committee? Why not put professional people on such a committee?" I do not mind whether or not you put "farmer" beside my name, but I think there should be some indication of the good people we do have on the committee.
