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<p>“That the Bill be not read the third time, but that it be referred back to the Committee of the Whole with instructions that they have power to amend the same by striking out paragraph 8 of clause 18, and to insert the following instead thereof:—On schooners and barges of from 25 to 100 tons, for each time the vessel uses the Harbour of Quebec, \$1, or on each vessel for the season \$5; on schooners and barges from 100 to 250 tons, \$1 for the first 100 tons, and one cent for each ton over 100 tons, or \$10 per annum.”—(<i>Mr. De St. Georges</i>.)</p>	
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
