

Order of Business

For Grand Lodge Meetings.

1. The Grand Lodge shall meet at — o'clock, A. M., and adjourn at — o'clock.
2. The G. W. O. T. shall take the Chair, and call the Lodge to order at the time to which it stands adjourned.
3. Reading and correcting the Journal of previous meeting.
4. Reports of Standing Committees.
5. Reports of Special Committees.
6. Petitions and Memorials.
7. Appeals.
8. Election and Installation of Officers.
9. Miscellaneous Business and Good of the Order.

Rules of Order.

1. The G. W. O. T. shall decide all questions of order, subject to an appeal to the Grand Lodge.
2. The G. W. O. T. shall appoint all Committees, unless otherwise directed by the Grand Lodge.
3. No member shall speak upon any question until first seconded and stated by the Chair.
4. No member shall speak more than twice on the same question, nor more than ten minutes, without special leave from the Grand Lodge.
5. No member shall be absent from the session of the Grand Lodge, without permission of the G. W. O. T.
6. A motion to adjourn shall always be in order, and to be taken without debate.
