I shall now, Sir, take my leave of you. with a very fincere wifh, that your retreat from the public fervice may appeale the malice of your enemies, and that your retirement may be undisturbed by reproach. If your conduct in this country has been improper, let it be confidered that it has carried its punifhment along with it .- Your conduct at Saratoga forms, indeed, too melancholy an epoch in our history ever to be forgottenbut when posterity shall learn of your defeat, may they be told with how much bravery you fought-may your merit go hand in hand with your misfortune-and may the amiable. part of your character live in the memory of your country, long after your harmlefs foibles, and unintentional errors shall be funk in shade. and buried in oblivion !
