The believer walks not after the flesh but after the spirit. He is under law to Christ, and the language of that law is, Be ye holy for I am holy, mortify every sin, perfect holiness in the fear of God, put off the old man with his affections and lusts, and put on the new man which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

In conclusion. *1st*, Unconverted soul, take hold of Christ. Now is the accepted time, behold now is the day of salvation. He that believeth not is condemned already, and the wrath of God abideth on him. *2nd*, Believer, rejoice, your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake, and your name is written in heaven. Who shall separate us from the love of God? Our duty is love, obedience, and holiness. "Behold what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us that we should be called the sons of God."—*Amen.*
