

"Let it be remembered too, that there is no Gallipoli in the record of the Canadian corps, no first battle of Cambrai, and no Fifth Army flasco. The one tragic episode in the C. E. F. history was at St. Julien, where Sir Sam's Ross rifles left the Canadians without a weapon to defend themselves against the encircling Huns.

"The most appalling losses suffered by the Canadian Corps were on the Somme, where they were commanded by Sir Julian Byng, now reputed to be the shrewdest general in the British Army, commanded by Byng, that refused to break before the tremendous Hun onslaught last year. Yet, on the Somme, practically nothing was done and little ground gained."

Compared With British Losses.

"When I think of how on August 10 of last year at the battle of Amiens I saw a Highland battalion go into battle in platoons in line, marching past us as if on parade, without a map or a sketch to indicate to them the ground over which they must advance and the objective they were to take, and when I remember how I saw those brave fellows come back, three or four of them left out of a whole platoon—well, then I realized how fortunate the Canadian corps were that they were not up against anything like that. It was almost as bad as the massed formation in which the Huns advanced into battle."

"While one of our divisions attacked Cambrai on one side the other three encircled it from the north, while the British circled around to the south. But it should be understood that there can hardly be a battle anywhere in that country without fighting in some hamlet or village street.

"The Canadian divisional commanders, such as Lipset and Macdonnell, were beloved by the men and spent days and days with the private soldiers in the front lines. They knew the conditions in which the men fought, knew them at first hand."
