On the foregoing words, attributed to a nameless author, The Telegram found a column of denunciation of Mr. Gooderham. There was no excuse for The Telegram's rage if the words in question correctly represented the nature of Mr. Gooderham's appeal to the people of Toronto.

But Mr. Gooderham has not, on any occasion, put forth such an absurd claim to recognition. We have no knowledge of any of his friends having done so. The words bear all the earmarks of The Telegram's own manufacture, and are similar to other statements and conjectures falsely attributed to Mr. Gooderham.

THE FACT OF THE "SETTLEMENT"

The fact of the "settlement" of the North Renfrew petition was a shameful procedure. While there were a great many charges against Mr. Dunlop, and some of the charges looked suspicious, such was the character of the campaign against him that the government was in no position to demand an investigation. It will not do to say that Mr. Dunlop's personal expenses, amounting, as he admits, to nearly \$8000, were sufficient to warrant the judges in depriving him of the right to sit in the legislature. By no act of his, the campaign was long-drawn-out. The candidate was in the midst of a heated fight for eighteen months, and the legitimate expenses were undoubtedly large. But if the government was able to show the expenditure of the candidate for the purpose of the campaign, it failed in its duty to the people when it consented to the withdrawal of the petition. And until The Globe is prepared to insist on a full investigation of election charges, it is idle to forbid freedom of speech to the member whose seat has been protected.

EQUIP THE FIRE BRIGADE

On Monday the mayor of Toronto will be called upon to express approval or disapproval of the proposed expenditure of \$700,000 for the purpose of bringing the efficiency of the fire defence equipment of the city up to the standard demanded by the Fire Unions' Association. The bylaw ought to commend itself to every citizen having the prosperity of the city at heart. Toronto has had a sad experience with fires. The utter inefficiency of the equipment at the disposal of the department on the occasion of the conflagration in the wholesale district in April last strengthened the demands of the insurance companies for an outlay of a large amount of money for fire protection purposes.

The interest of the underwriters in the passage of the \$700,000 bylaw is undoubtedly great. A good risk at a low premium is better than a bad risk at a high premium. Hence, the insurance companies are favorable to the bylaw. But the citizens who are called upon to pay the premiums demanded by the companies for the protection insurance afforded are as vitally concerned in the result of the voting on this bylaw.

The people have not been slow to meet the requirements of a rapidly growing city. They have provided the services demanded by expansion and development. The consent of the ratepayers was ungrudgingly given to the appropriation of a large sum for water mains. The proposal to fully equip the fire department with apparatus sufficient to cope with any emergency that might arise is a step in the right direction, and it is to be hoped that the bylaw will be carried.

URQUHART SOWED THE WIND; LET HIM REAP THE WHIRLWIND

The people of Toronto will not let the mistake of supposing that a vote for Mayor Urquhart is a vote for the separation of municipal politics and party politics in this city.
