Communications were sent to prominent men and women, asking their co-operation. Members of different societies were approached and requested to bring the subject before their assemblies, already many have sent out ringing resolutions favoring arbitration. Very many members of labour organizations profess themselves in favour of Boards of Arbitration, which shall be appointed by Government, for the settlements of all disputes between capital and labour.

On the 23rd of January, 1892, Professor Ashley of Toronto University, the distinguished Professor of Political Economy, delivered one of the best Lectures of the year dealing with the question of Industrial Peace. The Pan-Presbyterian Council, with thoughtful consideration, discussed this very important question, stating that in semi-barbaric ages force embodied the principle that by might not right weaker nations were brought into subjection, and might, ruled the world, but they claim that to-day, those who would preach the Gospel of the Prince of Peace must take higher ground, and as far as possible reverse the order of things by preaching "peace on earth good will to men."

These are straws which show the trend of public thought and we are glad to note that the current is in the right direction.
