EXTENT OF THE RECENT FRENCH ADVANCE IN CHAMPAGNE



The accompanying map, reproduced by courtesy of L'illustration, of Paris, shows the extent of the recent French offensive in Champagne on a front extending from Auberville to Villers-sur-Tourbe. The objective in this advance is the railway running through Somme-Py, paralleling the German line. This railway not only acts as a supply road for the German troops fighting even as far west as Rheims, but also supplies the German Crown Prince's army in the Argonne.

The black line in the map is the old French battle-line, before the advance of September 25. The dotted line underneath shows the territory gained by the French last February. The double hatched line shows the new battle-line. Since September 25 the French have advanced at two places, in the direction of Navarin farm and north of Tahure.

The Germans delivered a heavy attack, which was partially successful, a few days ago, just east of Auberville. The action is indicated on the map by the arrow.

PLANET LOST SIGHT OF FOR THIRTY-SIX YEARS

"93 Ambros" Was Found by Professor Solé, of Barcelona, Spain.

In a communication to the Academy of Sciences, announced that calculations made by Fabre and Blondel at Marseilles show that the new planet whose discovery was announced by Prof. Solé of the Barcelona Observatory is really "93 Ambros" which has been lost sight of for thirty-six years.
