

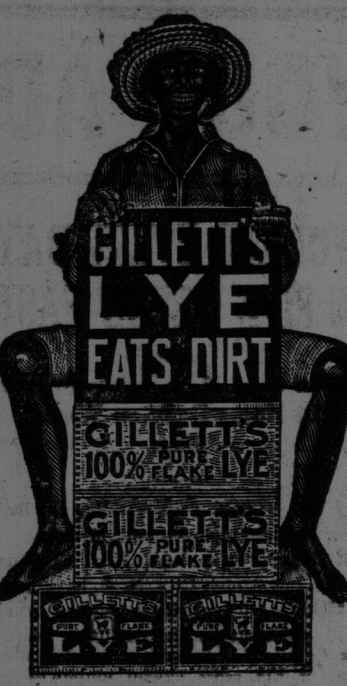

REV. DR. PILCHER GIVES SERMONS

Special Preacher is Heard at
Continuation of Centen-
nary Celebration.

Orangemen Parade to Carleton
Methodist Church—Rev. Dr.
Morison at St. Matthew's.

In St. John's (Stone) church yesterday special services were held in continuation of the centenary celebrations and Rev. Dr. C. V. Pilcher, of Weymouth, delivered sermons of great eloquence and fervor. The choir of the church under the leadership of Mrs. Douglas Frits, rendered special music and large congregations attended. In the morning St. Andrew's Society, one of the oldest societies in the city, presided to the service, marching from the society rooms in Germain street with two pipes leading the parade. Rev. A. L. Fleming, rector of the church, who is the chaplain of the society, conducted the services and was assisted by Rev. William Armstrong and Rev. John Unsworth. He announced that the centenary thank-offering of the congregation was already well above \$5,000 and asked that any further contributions be sent in as promptly as possible.



SEEK THE KINGDOM.

Dr. Pilcher believed that if there was one lesson which the present age most needed to learn it was the message "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God." He had just come from the Old Country where there was an industrial struggle going on and in the world today the spirit of unrest was everywhere apparent. The great statesmen had come to the realization that the solution was to be found only in the spirit of co-operation and of love, the spirit of Christ, and that this was to be the work of the Church of God. But there was another aspect Dr. Pilcher referred to, the personal aspect of conversion. He spoke of the magnificent service for Christ that could be accomplished if each individual would hear the call of Christ and follow Him.
