PUT DOWN CIVIL WAR AT ANY COST

That is the Order to Military Authorities in Disturbed Italy.

Rome, Aug. 8.—Burnings and blood shed continue in Italy. Drastic instructions have been issued to the military authorities to put down civil war at all costs and absolutely to prohibit demonstrations of all kinds.

Devastation of railroad men's clubs and Socialist buildings took place in Bologna. In the sackings, Fascist invaders seized several red flags, carrying them as trophies of war through the principal streets. A tremendous burning of the captured Socialist standards took place in the public square.

STIRRING FIGHT

Big Political Battle in Ohio Expected Over Senatorship.

Washington, Aug. 8.—(Canadian Press)

—Primaries in Ohio today for the nomination of candidates for the November elections are being watched with keen interest, chiefly because of the concern over the U. S. senatorship, though there are hard contests over the governorship nomination both among the Republicans and the Democrats and some interesting congressional fights.

It is assumed that Senator Alice Pomeroy, Democrat, will be nominated to succeed himself and that the Republican nominee will be Representative Simon W. Fess, until recently chairman of the Republican congressional committee.

If these two are placed in nomination, there will ensue one of the most animated campaigns Ohio has seen for years over the election of a senator, as between Republicans and Democrats.

SUN YAT SEN'S NORTHERN ARMY IS BADLY BEATEN

Canton, Aug. 8.—The northern army of Sun Yat Sen, deposed president of South China, is met stinging defeat by Chin Chung Ming's troops near Shiu-chow, in Northern Kwangtung province, and is in retreat back to Kiangsi province, where it came a few weeks ago, according to advices received here.
