Dog Menace to Wool.

Means by which the amount of wool produced in New York and New England may be increased were discussed Friday at Boston at a meeting of a commission including representatives of each of the seven states. The conference agreed to submit bills to their respective legislatures providing for the transfer of dog legislation from municipalities to the states and for the reimbursements of farmers for losses to establish centralized market places where both sheep and wool may be sold.
