Everett, Wash., Feb. 26.—The snow
lockade on the Great Northern rail-
road grows worse each hour instead of
better. A heavy snow fell all night
in the mountains, completely wiping out
all little work had been done to clear
the tracks. The six stalled passenger
trains are standing to-day in the same
spot they have been blocked for three
days.

passenger trains were wrecked last night

passenger No. 277, due in Everett at

It was not seriously. Passengers walked
Mukilteo and took the ferry to Bel-
lingham. The next train along ran into
washout south of Bellingham and
was derailed. The line will be cleared
soon.

porter. Olson's body has been found.

QUESTION OF CHINESE

MIXING WITH WHITES

Liquor License Bill—Land Act

There were two divisions taken this
afternoon on the report stage of
the public schools amending bill. Of
the two the most important matter on
the agenda of the day was that of
the attendance of Oriental children in
the schools in company with white
children. An amendment to the Public
Schools Act was proposed, the ob-
ject being to give boards the power to
exclude children from the public
schools for racial reasons. The actual
object of the bill, as stated by the
speaker a few days ago, was to force
the matter to the attention of the public
and compel the government to provide
schools where Oriental children may
be educated apart from whites.

The minister of education looked on
this as the introduction of the sepa-
rate school system and declared him-
self against it.

The liquor act was finally passed in
committee and stands for report. H.

strengthen the act. He proposed to
strengthen the act by providing for
the liquor to certain classes of persons.
The liquor act amendments which in-
clude the adoption of the Liberal

second time.
