VICTIMS WERE ALL CHILDREN

TERRIBLE SCENE IN ENGLISH PUBLIC HALL Staircase Strawn With Dead and Dying—Life Trampled Out of Sixteen.

Barnesley, England, Jan. 11.—The panic in which sixteen children were trampled to death and forty others, several of whom cannot live, were injured in a mad rush for better seats at an entertainment given in the public hall here this afternoon, was of a shocking character.

Police and ushers rushed to the head of the staircase, which was literally strewn with dead and dying, and by most desperate efforts, managed to drag scores of the struggling children to the corridors below.
