

Course of Instruction in the Faculty of Medicine.

(The Didactic Lectures are delivered in the College Building, corner Carlton and College Streets.)

I.—MEDICINE.

Prof. REID, Superintendent of Nova Scotia Hospital for the Insane.
Prof. LAWSON, Physician to Prov. & City Hospital, Orphans' Home, Blind Asylum.

Divided into Principles and Practice. This course will be illustrated by Coloured Plates, Morbid Preparations, and recent Pathological Specimens.

Text Books.—Tanner, Flint, Watson, Barthelow, Niemeyer, Roberts.

II.—SURGERY.

Prof. FARRELL, Surgeon to Provincial and City Hospital, Consulting Surgeon to Halifax Dispensary.

Divided into Principles and Practice, including Surgical Anatomy and Operative Surgery, exhibited on the subject. The various surgical instruments and apparatus are shown, and their uses and mode of application illustrated.

Text Books.—Druitt, Erichsen, Gross, Holmes, Bryant.

III.—OBSETRICS.

Prof. SLATTERY, Consulting Surgeon to Provincial and City Hospital.

This course includes Diseases of Women and Children, and is illustrated by plates, manikins, etc. Every facility is given to senior students for attending midwifery cases at the Almshouse and Dispensary, under direction of the medical officers.

IV.—CHEMISTRY.

The Lectures on this subject are given by Prof. GEORGE LAWSON, at Dalhousie College.

This course is illustrated by Diagrams, Tables, Apparatus, Preparations, and Demonstrations on the black-board.
