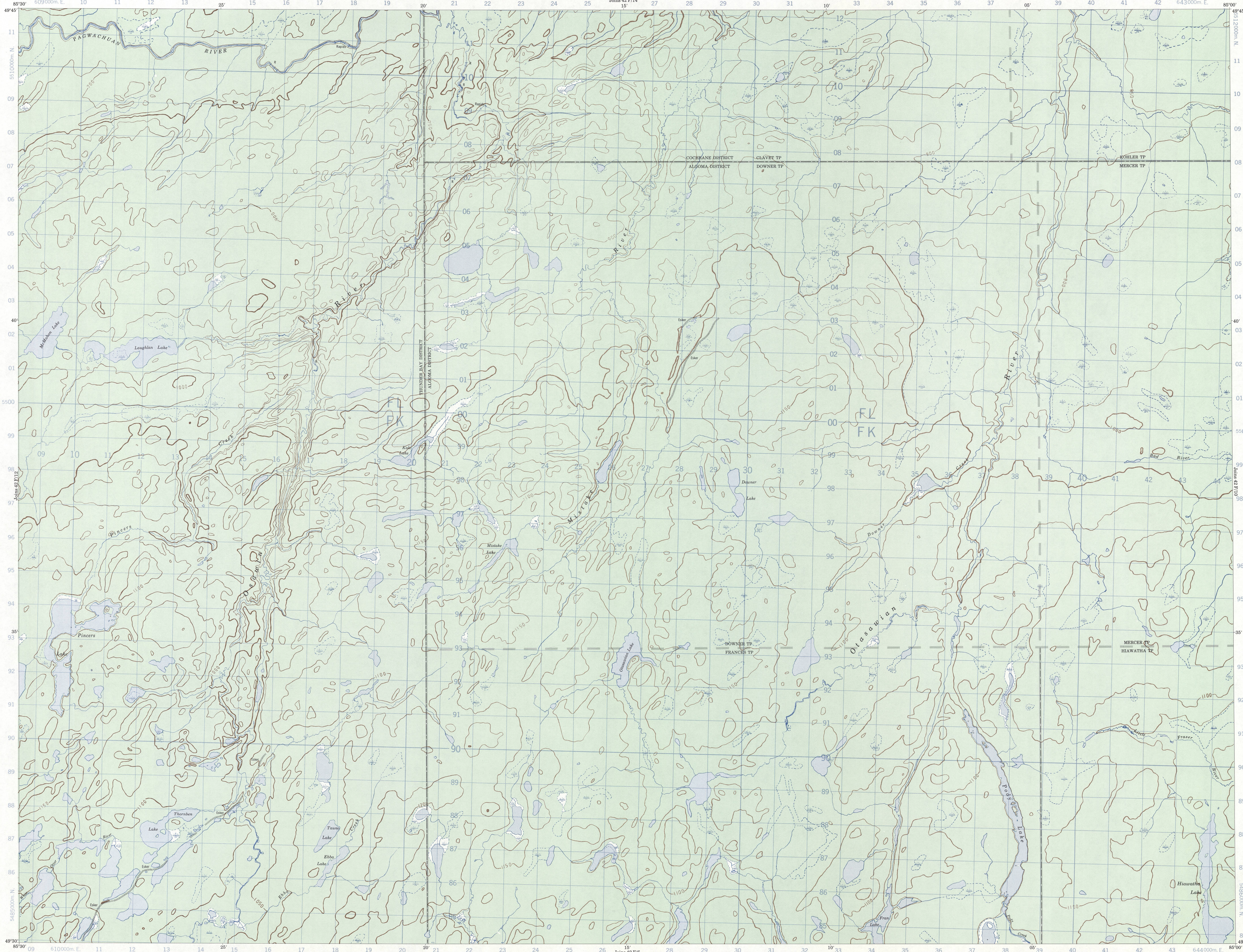

TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SIMPLE ONE
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THE MAP

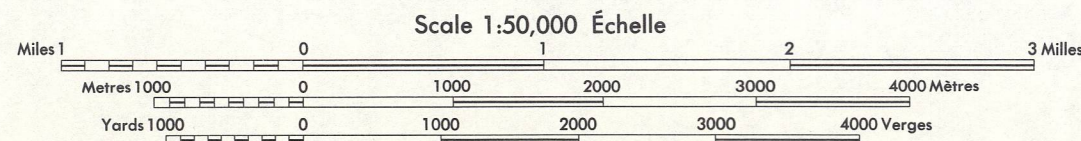
REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (see above)
EASTING: Road number on grid line immediately south of point	97
Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point	5
NORTHING: Road number on grid line immediately below point	95
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	4

EXAMPLE GRID REFERENCE 979504
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
