**REGISTRATION OF VITAL STATISTICS TO BE CONSIDERED**

St. John Presbytery Appoints Committee To Look Into This Matter—Harvey Minister's Resignation Accepted.

The Presbytery of St. John at its quarterly meeting held yesterday appointed a committee to consider the matter of vital statistics and report on the best methods in their estimation of having these registered. A committee was also appointed to confer with the Anglican committee on the Bible in the public schools. The resignation of Rev. J. F. MacKay, Harvey, was accepted and the pulpit will be declared vacant the first Sunday in September, and several matters of routine business were discussed.
