SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES

Is Dealing With Appeals by Rhode Island and New Jersey from Prohibition Legislation.

Washington, April 22.—Validity of the Prohibition Amendment and portions of the Enforcement Act was involved in seven separate proceedings before the Supreme Court.
