By a comparison of the contributions of 1894 with those of former years, it will be seen that there is a decrease in almost every direction. In searching for a cause for this shortage it may be attributed to a number of things: 1. There is the general depression in nearly all lines of business, which has affected our town to a considerable extent. 2. It was not necessary that so much should be raised for General Revenue, as the expenses this year were less than for some time. 3. Many of our people felt they had been giving too much for the support of Missions and the other schemes of the church, and this year lowered their offering. 4. Owing to the vacancy and the settlement of a new pastor the interest of the people in the outside work of the church was allowed to subside. 5. During the year a number of our best supporters have removed from our midst, and some of those who have taken their places have not as yet fully adopted our plan of giving.

During the past year our communion roll has suffered more than usual. There has been a continued call for certificates, and by a
