LACEY OF SPRINGFIELD FOR BRANTFORD TEAM.

"Knotty" Lacey returned yesterday to Brantford and reported that he has not signed any new men, but stated that he had secured recommendations of several players. Lacey, a port-sider of Springfield, Mass., will likely be given a tryout, being highly recommended by Justin of Toronto. The players on the Red Sox roster will report for training on Monday next. The grounds are in good condition, though the blizzard of last night does not promise good spring training weather.

INTERCHANGE FLAGS.

The Michigan-Ontario Leaguers now are stepping to the front with talk about their inaugurations on May 15. In all of the cities there will be elaborate ceremonies to mark the resumption of the sport.

Battle Creek, which has a home opening in which it will be assisted by London, is the first to make preparations. George Black, who had the original South Michigan League club, and who now manages the Post Theatre, has been put in charge of festivities, and will have the co-operation of Colonel Hutchison in charge at Camp Custer.

One of interesting features of the Michigan openings will be the interchange of flags. London has planned to bring to Battle Creek for use on one of the park poles a big Canadian flag and will take home in exchange an American flag, the gift of the Battle Creek club. It is expected similar exchanges will be made by teams that are paired in Michigan cities for opening day. In each of the cities efforts will be made to have a half holiday proclaimed.—A Detroit Summary

TORONTO SECURES NEW CATCHER

Catcher Hafner of Philadelphia, who accepted terms with the Toronto club, yesterday notified Manager Gibson that owing to inability to secure a furlough from the Pennsylvania & Philadelphia Railway, with whom he holds a responsible position, he would be unable to report.

The Leafs' leader immediately got busy and last evening completed arrangements whereby "Catcher" Sandberg, last season with the Rochester team, and who was only recently mustered out of the United States navy, will join the Leafs in Newark tomorrow, where he will work out with several of the local hurlers. Sandberg is a promising backstop and last season did good work for the Hartford team.
