

DICKINSON, MOSS KENT. (*Russell.*)

A lineal descendant of one of the Pilgrim Fathers who came to New England in the "Mayflower." His father, Barnabas Dickinson, came to Can. 1812, and, founded the town of Dickinson's Landing, Ont. B. in the State of New York, 1822, but has been resident permanently in Canada since 1828. M., 1846, Elizabeth Mary, dau. of the late W. Twigge, Toronto. Was for some years extensively engaged in the forwarding trade, and subsequently was a manufacturer of sawn lumber with J. M. Currier, Ottawa. Removed, 1870, to Manotick, which he founded. Is a manufacturer. Was Mayor of Ottawa City, 1864, 1865, 1866. First elected to Parlt. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Manotick, Ont.*

DODD, MURRAY Q.C. (*Cape Breton.*)

Grandfather, Hon. Archibald Charles Dodd, came to Cape Breton from Eng. in 1786, and was shortly afterwards apptd. Presdt. of the Council of the Island of Cape Breton. He subsequently was apptd. Chief Justice, and, while acting as such, administered the Govt. of the Island for a short period of time. S. of the Hon. Edmund Murray Dodd, Judge of the Supreme Court of N.S. for twenty-six years, by Caroline Maria, dau. of the late John Ritchie, Esq., of Sydney. B. 23 May, 1843. Ed. at Sydney and Sackville, N.B. M., at Sydney Mines, 18 Dec. 1879, Laura Isabel, second dau. of Blowers Archibald, Esq., of Sydney Mines. Called to the Bar, N.S., 2 May 1865. Apptd. Q.C., 11 Oct. 1880. Was Registrar of the Court of Probate for the Co. of Cape Breton from 1 Oct. 1867, until 10 July, 1872, when appointed Judge of Probate for said Co. Resigned in Oct. 1879, when he unsuccessfully contested Cape Breton for the Commons, on the death of the sitting mem. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Sydney, Cape Breton, N.S.*

DUGAS, FIRMIN. (*Montcalm.*)

S. of the late Lient-Col. Philemon Dugas, who emigrated from the U.S. to Can. in 1816, and was one of the first settlers of the Tp. of Rawdon, Co. Montcalm, P.Q. B. at Rawdon, 1830. Ed. at L'Assomption CoH. M., 1st, 1851, Miss Adeline Pominville, (she d. 22 June, 1859); 2nd, Miss Mary Ann Reinhardt, (she d. 24 July 1871.) 3rd, Mary Anastacea, relict of the late James Daly, Esq.,
