An Act to continue, until the Thirty-first Day of December One thousand eight hundred and thirtytwo, certain Acts relating to the Island of Newfoundland, and the Fisheries carried on upon the Banks and Shores thereof. [14th May 1829.]

HEREAS an Act was passed in the Fifth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act to repeal several 5 G. 4. c. 51. Laws relating to the Fisheries carried on upon the Banks and Shores of Newfoundland, and to make Provision for the better Conduct of the said Fisheries for Five Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament: And whereas a certain other Act was passed in the Fifth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act for the better Administration of Justice in 5 G. 4. c. 67. Newfoundland, and for other Purposes: And whereas a certain other Act was passed in the said Fifth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act to repeal an Act passed in the Fifty-seventh Year of the 5 G. 4. c. 68. Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled 'An Act 'to regulate the Celebration of Marriages in Newfoundland, and to 'make further Provision for the Celebration of Marriages in the said 'Colony and its Dependencies:' And whereas the said recited Acts will shortly expire, and it is expedient that the same should be continued in force for a limited Time; be it therefore and it is hereby enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same,
