at Kamsack townsite as at January 26th, 1922.

You will note from the statement enclosed that
payment in full of lot 19 Block 20 has been completed. The
original purchaser of this lot was G. E. Coffin but this party
assigned his interest in the lot to Chas. E. Tran, Physician
and Surgeon, Kamsack.

In this connection we would refer you to our letter
of December 14th, 1920 wherein we enclosed an assignment cover-
ing lots 18 and 19 from Chas. Edgar Coffin to Dr. Chas. E.
