

Indian Office Memorandum
December 4th 1876

Sir

I have the honor to inclose copy of the license issued to Messrs R.A. Lyon & Co. to cut timber in part of the Township of Sandfield, by authority of official letter No 5082 dated Oct 21. last, and also copy of a communication from Messrs R.A. Lyon & Co. on the subject, objecting to the clause by which any lots that may be subsequently occupied and improved are to be excluded from the operation of the license on the 30th April next after such occupation:— and asking that the same time be allowed for cutting of the timber (three years) as is allowed them in the other limit they have leased from the Department.
