2. Administration, Maintenance & Training.

With these estimates it is planned to increase -

- (a) Permanent Force from a total of 147 officers and 933 airmen to 195 officers and 1498 Airmen, representing an increase of 48 officers and 565 airmen, and
- (b) the Non-Permanent Active Air Force from 97 officers and 666 airmen to 118 officers and 946 airmen, representing an increase of 21 officers and 280 airmen,

making a total strength of 313 officers and 2,444 airmen in the combined Permanent and Non-Permanent Forces.
