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~~86~~ items provision is made for reductions
in the existing intermediate rates of duty
and in the case of ⁹⁴~~92~~ items for the maint-
enance of the existing intermediate rates
of duty. During the three years duration
of the Agreement, Canada may not increase
the intermediate rates of these items.

If it should be found that the granting
of the Intermediate Tariff on any items not
included in Schedule (1) involved too great
a reduction in the reasonable protection
which might be expected for a Canadian ind-
ustry, Parliament is free to increase the
rates of duty.

Further Safeguards

Moreover, the anti-dumping provisions
of the Canadian Tariff are still in effect and
so far as values for duty are concerned the
commitments have been made to the United States
chiefly with a view to eliminating arbitrary
executive interference with the normal course
of trade. Full safeguards have been retained

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
