"Creek, 25 inches from Bate's Creek and all the water
"from all other sources of water supply on the reserve."

I would call your attention to the fact that
it would be necessary for you to furnish the Department
with the original transfer of lease to yourself and with
a certified copy of the Order-in-Council which you state
has been passed by the local Government, quit-claiming
its interest in the property in question.
