

Larger barn, Plans and Specifica-
-tions must be furnished giving
details and stating the cost
of the enlarged barn.

And as regards the dwell-
-ing house, Plans and Specifica-
-tions must also be sent giving
all details as to the size the
house was at first to be, and the
reduced size and the reduced
cost thereof.

As soon as you have
furnished these Plans and
Specifications and the consent
of Mrs. Fisher to allow the building
to store the grain grown on the
adjacent farm in a barn
built on her land, and at her
expense, the matter will be
taken
