2. PREPARE 5 COPIES - RETAIN COPY 5 AND FORWARD COPIES 1, 2, 3 AND 4 TO REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS BY JULY 31ST.
3. AFTER REVIEW, REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS WILL RETAIN COPY 4 OF EACH AGENCY SUBMISSION AND FORWARD REMAINDER TO OTTAWA BY AUGUST 31ST ACCOMPANIED BY MEMORANDUM INDICATING REGIONAL PRIORITY RECOMMENDED.
4. ANY PLANS, PHOTOGRAPHS OR OTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED TO ASSIST IN THE COMPLETION OF THE SURVEY REQUEST MAY BE OBTAINED BY REQUEST TO BRANCH HEADQUARTERS.
5. INCLUDE APPROPRIATE BAND COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS CONSENTING TO THE SURVEY AND/OR AUTHORIZING USE OF BAND FUNDS IN PAYMENT OF SURVEY COSTS IN WHOLE OR IN PART.
6. PROVIDE SKETCH, PLAN, MAP OR DESCRIPTION SHOWING CLEARLY THE AREA COVERED BY THE REQUEST.

PRELIMINARY SURVEYS THE SURVEY IS REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- (A) A PLAN IS REQUIRED FOR ADMIN. PURPOSES SHOWING EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS.
- (B) A PLAN IS REQUIRED ON WHICH TO BASE:
 - (i) A SUBDIVISION OF PRESENTLY OCCUPIED OR ALLOTTED LAND (INDIVIDUAL HOLDINGS).
 - (ii) A SUBDIVISION OF UNALLOTTED LAND (FUTURE BAND NEEDS OR FOR LEASING PURPOSES).
 - (iii) AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STUDY.
- (C) SURRENDER SALE SHORT TERM LEASE LONG TERM LEASE
