

According to Mr. Castell Hopkins, Editor of the authoritative "Canadian Annual Review," in his book "Canada at War," the number of persons employed in war industry in the last war was 275,000 persons, including 12,000 women. These figures he drew from the reports of the Department of Labour and of the Imperial Munitions Board.

According to the Department of Munitions and Supply, the number of persons engaged in war production in Canada today is 550,000 men and 75,000 women,-total 625,000.
