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to have candidly stated his true situation and to
have shewn to His Excellency that he had complied
with those terms upon which alone he could be
entitled to the privileges of a British Subject
in this Colony, on this account His Excellency
may probably consider it expedient to require
from Mr Walsley the necessary Evidence to
establish his Naturalisation before granting any
Order to authorize the examination of Mr Walsley
as to his professional Qualifications.
