

- Q. What I am suggesting is that he said to you something and you corrected it to put it in proper grammar?
A. I changed nothing. I would say it over to him and he would agree and then I would put it down.
- Q. In this statement he told you some things he had already told you before?
A. That's right.
- Q. Why were they included? Did you ask any questions?
A. No sir. When he said he wanted to make a statement I told him to start at the beginning and carry right through to the end.
- Q. While he was talking you never interrupted or questioned him?
A. I probably questioned him as to his meaning.
- Q. Did you ask him any question for the purpose of getting further information?
A. He started actually from the night of the 5th. He didn't say anything about the day before so I asked him if he would start from the beginning.
- Q. He didn't say the last paragraph?
A. No sir, not that one. I said that to him before he made the statement. He agreed to it going in.
- Q. It is actually not his own statement?
A. No.
- Q. He agreed to it going in?
A. Yes. I read it over to him and handed it over to him and then he signed.
- Q. Did he read it?
A. I read it to him and handed it to him. I'm not sure if he read it all.
- Q. Is this the first time you cautioned him?
A. No sir. I cautioned him on the 5th at the Orderly Room.
- Q. Did anyone else speak to him?
A. I didn't hear anyone.
- Q. Did you hear QMS Weir tell him to tell the truth and the CO would handle it?
A. No sir.
- Q. Did you hear anybody suggest to him that he should tell you the truth or tell you anything?
A. No sir. At the time both Naylor and Weir were doubtful that he was the man.
